1. CALL TO ORDER *Meeting was called to order at 11:07 A.M..*
2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE (Salute, pledge...) *Nathan Ancelet led us in the Pledge of Allegiance.*
3. ROLL CALL *Nathan Ancelet, Gabe Barnes, Alyssa Buendia, Jeff Covert, Raquel Good, Jiulong Li, Jacob Thornton, Nao Ukita, Nathaniel Williams, Masato Yoshimi, and Jose Gomez were present at this meeting.*
4. APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA *Motioned by Raquel Good, seconded by Nathaniel Williams, and motion was passed unanimously.*
5. APPROVAL OF MINUTES *Motioned by Raquel Good, seconded by Gabe Barnes, and motion was passed unanimously.*
6. SWEARING IN OF OFFICERS *There were no officers to be sworn in this meeting.*
7. PUBLIC COMMENT
This segment of the meeting is reserved for persons desiring to address the SCSS on any matter of concern that is not stated on the agenda. A time limit of three (3) minutes per speaker and fifteen (15) minutes per topic shall be observed. 8. OLD BUSINESS
 - a. **General Assembly-** Senate will have further discussion of General Assembly. *Jiulong mentioned that Senate will be funding two additional students to come on the trip. He also described the cost of attending the General Assembly. Nathan Ancelet motioned to approve Senate sending one advisor and three Senate members to the General Assembly, Raquel Good seconded, and motion was passed unanimously.*
9. NEW BUSINESS
 - a. **Club Approval-** Senate will discuss and possibly approve the Intercultural Club *Motioned by Raquel Good, seconded by Gabe Barnes, and motion was passed unanimously.*
 - b. **Renewal-** Senate will discuss and possibly approve the SCSS certificates of deposits. *Motioned by Raquel Good and seconded by Nathan Ancelet. Debate on what certificates of deposits are. Motion passed unanimously.*
 - c. **Food Drive-** Senate will discuss the efforts and details about the Food Drive. *Motion to have the food drive made by Raquel Good; seconded by Nathaniel Williams; motion passed. Raquel*



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Good motioned referring 9b to a committee. Alyssa Buendia mentioned she had already tried to make a committee but only one person had signed up; she stressed the importance of knowing whether or not she should start planning for a Food Drive. It was decided that there be a food drive in October and one in November (for Thanksgiving).

- d. **Club Approval** - Senate will discuss and possibly approve the renewal of the Lance. *Motioned by Raquel to approve both 9d and 9e, seconded by Gabe Barnes, and motion was passed unanimously.*
- e. **Club Approval** – Senate will discuss and possibly approve the renewal of the Puente Club. *Motioned by Raquel to approve both 9d and 9e, seconded by Gabe Barnes, and motion was passed unanimously.*
- f. **Region 1 Meeting**- Senate will discuss and possibly approve hosting the next Region 1 meeting on October 22 *See 9d.*

10. STANDING OR SPECIAL COMMITTEE REPORTS

The following written reports are provided for informational and accountability purposes. These reports will be considered officially accepted by the Student Senate Executive Board upon adoption of their agenda.

- a. **President's Report** (Emily Groth) *Emily informed us that she would like everyone to be trained in the office. She will be emailing us regarding this training.*
- b. **Vice President's Report** (Nathan Ancelet) *Nathan reported that he has been in contact with Cullen, who has been very helpful in training him on VP duties and office work. Nathan would like to make sure everyone is trained well in their position.*
- c. **Treasurer's Report** (Masato Yoshimi) *Masato reported on our current budget along with the \$3000 cost of the General Assembly.*
- d. **Events & Activities Report** (Alyssa Buendia) *Alyssa reported on Transfer Day, the Blood Drive, Preview Day, and Costume Club Kick-Off.*
- e. **Public Relations Officer** (Jacob Thorton) *Jacob mentioned that he is still in the process of being trained and that he has made contact with Cullen on a time to receive an in-depth training. He would like to make strong connections with local businesses this school year.*
- f. **Regional Affair Officer** (Jiulong Li) *Jiulong spoke about the General Assembly and also the regional meeting that will take place at our school next month.*
- g. **Participatory Committee Representative Reports** (Senators) *Alyssa Buendia spoke regarding the Student Success Committee, which she attended on the Thursday before this meeting; she described Starfish, a program that Shasta College is looking into adopting for the school. This program included the students' ability to their build own educational plans.*
