1. **ACCT 103 PC Accounting**
Proposed revision: Adding DE delivery format.
2. **ADAP 100 College Success for Students with Disabilities –**
Proposed revision: Change in hours to better meet the needs of students (from 36 lecture/54 lab change to 54 lecture). Change in objectives. Course content entirely rewritten so that the content, pedagogical delivery and total hours are aligned to better meet the needs of students.
3. **ADAP 102 Orientation to College- New Course (Attachment)**
Proposed discipline/FSA: Adaptive Studies/Special Education
4. **ADAP 200 Preparation for College – New Course (Attachment)**
Proposed discipline/FSA: Adaptive Studies/Special Education
5. **ACSS Essay Requirements for Transfer Level Courses**
Proposed discussion: Granting the opportunity to utilize skills demonstration in lieu of essays as a more appropriate evaluation tool of demonstrated proficiency in the subject matter for certain transfer level courses. This allowance is permitted in Title V Section 5502 (a)(92)(A).
6. **ART 60A Basic Photography and Darkroom**
Proposed revision: Change in hours to more accurately reflect a 3 unit course (from 36 lecture/72 lab to 27 lecture/81 lab).
7. **ART 80A Graphic Design**
Proposed revision: Unit change from 2 to 3 units (along with hour change – was 18 lec/36 lab to 27 lec/81 lab). Advisory added. Catalog description, content and objectives updated and increased to reflect unit value increase.
8. **ART 80B Intermediate Graphic Design {formerly ART 80B Graphic Design}**
Proposed revision: Name change. Unit change from 2 to 3 units (along with hour change – was 18 lec/36 lab to 27 lec/81 lab). Advisory added. Catalog description, content and objectives updated and increased to reflect unit value increase.
9. **BUAD 76 Sales {formerly MKTG 70 Sales}**
Proposed revision: Course number and title change. Students are not finding the course because they assume that it is a business course. This change was recommended by the BUAD Program
10. **BUAD 77 Principles of Marketing {formerly MKTG 74 Principles of Marketing}**
Proposed revision: Course number and title change. Students are not finding the course because they assume that it is a business course. This change was recommended by the BUAD Program Review Committee and the BUAD Advisory Committee. Note on the old outline was deleted – it was correct in Datatel and the catalog. This course may be taught utilizing an ITV delivery method.

- 11. BUAD 176 Retail Management {formerly MKTG 176 Retail Management}**
Proposed revision: Course title change. Students are not finding the course because they assume that it is a business course. This change was recommended by the BUAD Program Review Committee and the BUAD Advisory Committee. Catalog description changed.
- 12. CIS 39 Cisco Networking – CCNA Security {formerly CIS 39 Cisco Networking – Fundamentals of Network Security} –**
Proposed revision: Name change to match the new Network Security curriculum from Cisco. Revised lecture and lab hours (was 36 lec/54 lab to 45 lec/27 lab + 162 DE). Major revisions to objectives and content and catalog description.
- 13. CIS 63 Assembly Language Programming-**
Proposed revision: Revised prerequisite
- 14. CIS Program Changes**
Proposed changes: Proposed changes in the AS Degree with BIS Concentration, AS Degree CCNA Option, Certificate – CCNA option, AS Degree CCNP Option, and Certificate – CCNP Option
- 15. COM 21 Multi-Media Authoring**
Proposed revision: Adding DE delivery format. Minor changes in content, objectives and catalog description.
- 16. COM 30 Introduction to Audio Recording**
Proposed revision: Adding DE delivery format. Minor changes in content, objectives and catalog description.
- 17. COM 31 Introduction to Digital Audio**
Proposed revision: Adding DE delivery format. Minor changes in content, objectives and catalog description.
- 18. Communication Studies Degree**
Proposed revision: Replacing THTR 12, Acting for the State I, with COM 21, Multi-Media Authoring.
- 19. ECE 7 Early Childhood Observation and Assessment –**
Proposed revision: Change to prerequisite, course description, content and objectives to align with the CA Early Childhood Education CAP program's guidelines and verbiage. The lecture portion of this course may be taught utilizing and ITV delivery method.
- 20. ECE 8 Teaching Practicum for Young Children {formerly ECE 8 Teaching Practices for Young Children} –**
Proposed revision: Name change. Minor changes to content, objectives and catalog description.
- 21. ECE 15 Child Health, Safety and Nutrition {formerly ECE 15 Health and Safety in children's Programs} –**
Proposed revision: Name change. Minor changes in content, objectives and catalog description to align with the CA Early Childhood Education CAP program.
- 22. ENGL 33 Fiction and Film**
Proposed revision: Adding DE delivery format. Objectives updated to correlate with current prerequisite.

23. ENGL 297 Special Topics in Reading

Proposed revision: Adding English Literature and Composition to the FSA making it consistent with the other 200-level reading courses. Also, the ENGL 297 course outline mentions writing skills being within the scope of this course, making English FSAs appropriate

24. ESL 234 Intermediate High

Proposed revision: Unit increase (from 4 units to 5 units), hour change, advisory change, content and objectives change and catalog description change. The ESL program is streamlining the ESL course sequence from 8 to 5 because our current ESL population possesses much higher literacy skills than previous populations. Thus, it requires less skill development in English reading and writing. Some of the course content of ESL 235 is being integrated into ESL 234 and ESL 236.

25. FSS 18 Adulthood and Aging

Proposed revision: Change in discipline/FSA by adding Sociology/Social Work. This additional Discipline/FSA has been added to align with the Family Studies Program Mission. Change in content and objectives. This course may be taught utilizing an ITV delivery method.

26. FSS Degree Change to Catalog

Proposed revision: Requesting that the following options be added to the FSS AS degree: FSS 25 (Nutrition) OR BIOL 5 (Biology) and FSS 46 (Personal Finance) OR ECON 1A or ECON 1B. This action follows the recommendation made by counselors and our Family Studies Advisory Board to give the students that are interested in transferring to a 4-year BSW Program (Bachelor's of Social Work) a chance to major in Family Studies at the two year level and minimize the additional coursework required to transfer.

27. PE 15 Aerobic Dance

Proposed revision: Units made consistent with current practice of .5-1 unit offering (was .5-1.5). Hours adjusted to 27-54 to correspond to the unit values. Content and objectives rewritten and condensed.

28. PHSC 1 Physical Science Survey

Proposed revision: Deleted Earth Science from FSA (now just Chemistry, Physics/Astronomy). Updated textbook information.

29. PSYC 5 Human Sexuality {formerly PHY 5 Human Sexuality}

Proposed revision: Change discipline to Psychology because many campuses place Human Sexuality in the Social Sciences. This was agreed to by the Science faculty. Change in Discipline/FSA to PSYC/Biological Sciences; Counseling; Health; Psychology (was PHY/Biological Sciences; Counseling; Health; Psychology). Minor change to description. Change to note. Objectives and Distance Education updated.

30. THTR 34 Makeup

Proposed revision: Added repeatability for further skill development. Changes in content, objectives and catalog description.
