5. Discussion/Action Items

a. Kevin O'Rorke and Lois Cushnie - Matriculation funds

Question- Were the Degree/Certificate sequences put online as discussed at the last meeting of Senate? He said that they were all done and online and available to students.

Matriculation has been cut 62% in funding for this year. This will change how counselors do their job. Currently full time counselors' loads are full. Approx. 5000 students need counseling each year (testing, counseling and placement). If all part time counselors are cut then will see an impact on students:

- Reduced book vouchers
- Not all students coming in spring will see counselor for individual appointment.
- Longer wait at A and R
- Students will have quicker appointments; this could result in mistakes in placement.
- Students will have to wait longer to see counselors
- Longer waits for degree audits
- Reduced outreach
- Math self placement means we don't have to buy math tests.
 (Chancellors office is now looking at EAP results to place students in Math and English classes. This might cut back on number of test we need to buy.)

Very difficult to have funding cut when we have record high enrollments.

b. Budget (Joe Wyse): Joe explained how the cut in state funding is impacting Shasta College.

Had handout on the state of the college budget and power point presentation. Federal backfill dollars 16% of what was projected. \$2.2 mil. Deficit. Found \$1,047,000 in savings. Need to find \$996,438 in cuts. But this could change as

more cuts may come mid year and STRS and PERS costs for employers may increase by 3% or more.

Questions were asked about FTES and other cost savings.

- c. Hiring Priorities Procedure: The deans are recommending that we suspend the Hiring Priorities Procedure for one year. (Bill Cochran) The reason is that deans are recommending that the hiring priority be suspended is that there are no funds to hire. Maureen Stephens moved to suspend the process for one year, Ray Nicolas seconded-motion passed –Terry Bailey and Leimone Waite abstained-, Ramon Tello opposed
