- Active member of a bona-fide taxpayers' association
- Active member of a support organization for the District, such as a foundation
- Member of the community at-large

Employees, vendors, contractors and consultants of the Shasta-Tehama-Trinity Joint Community College District are prohibited by law from being members of the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee.

The deadline to submit your application is 4:30 PM on June 8, 2017.
