Measure H Update Report

Many exciting projects supported by Measure H are happening across campus this summer, with a few quick highlights mentioned below. - **Veterans Support and Success Center:** our new Veterans Center is moving along quickly, with the foundation poured and walls going up!
- **CTE Building and Covered Storage:** this new building will round out the CTE quad (buildings 2400, 2500 and 2600), and will house our Advanced Manufacturing and Machining program. Demolition of a couple of wooden structures is complete, and the foundation will be started soon.
- **Infrastructure and Walkways:** new walkways you can see (from the new Campus Safety building to the 700 building, and from the 2300 building to the Athletic Fieldhouse – dubbed the “Graduation Walkway”) and infrastructure you can’t see (sewer repair, water line extension, etc.) are welcome upgrades to our campus and should be completed by the end of August.
- **Solar Carport – East Parking Lot:** the last of the fencing is now removed and the entire lot is open for student parking. Charging stations are still waiting for hookups, but will be coming soon.
