Simpson University requires at least 24 credits upper division credits in the major and 36 upper division credits in the total program for a bachelor's degree. All credits tranferred from Shasta College are lower division.

Students must fulfill the graduation requirements in effect at the time of their actual enrollment at Simpson University.

Student who qualify for admissions to Simpson University may transfer at any time. There is no minimum number of transfer credits required before transferring to Simpson University.

Students must take at least 30 credits (12 of which must be in their major) and their last 15 of 24 credits at Simpson University.

For some majors, certain foundational studies options become part of the major (such as Statistics for Business Administration major and Cultural Anthropology for the Cross-Cultural Studies major). Studenst in these majors should plan their programs accordingly.
