 \$ 4.3 million for 800 Building Renovation
- Potential State Funding (\$14.5 M) \$5.2 million for 1600 Building Renovation
 \$9.3 million for Theatre Complex Reconstruction
- Stimulus Funds contributing to Projects (Est. \$3 million)
- Interest Earned on Bond Proceeds in County Treasury (Est. \$4.5 million)
- Strong Workforce Program Funding (\$358,000), CCCCO, Fire Chief's Association Contributions
- Potential Scheduled Maintenance Funds contributing to Bond Projects (amount TBD)

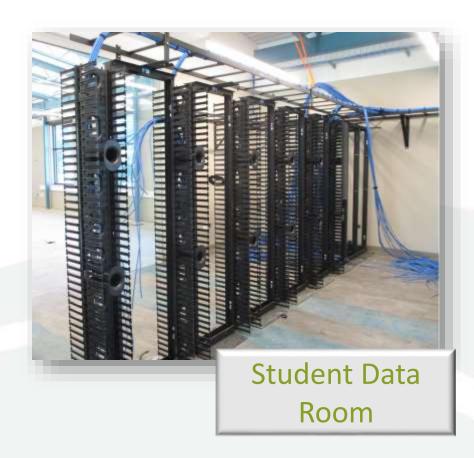






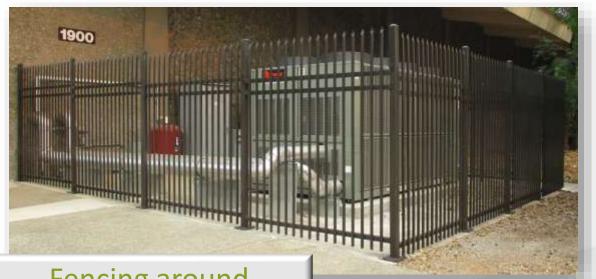

- Solar Project East Parking Lot (Project complete and undergoing PG&E testing)
- **200 Building (Library) Modernization Project** (Construction documents submitted to the Division of the State Architect [DSA] on September 1st; detailed furniture planning to commence)
- SC Main Campus Keying & Access Control (Phase II door hardware received and currently being installed using phased approach for most-used student areas; Phase III – Electronic access equipment (AMAG) purchase and installation to move forward soon)
- 2400-2500-2600 Buildings HVAC & Exterior Refresh (Construction documents submitted to DSA on July 22nd; comments from DSA received August 28th and are undergoing review; HVAC replacement approved for Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) stimulus funds of just over \$1 million)
