Summary Date: 11/15/2017

Summary of findings: The PRC recommends this program continue without qualification. The program has averaged 11.8 completers per year over the past five years. There are no “core” courses; students choose 18 units from among an array of classes in three areas. The five-year average success rates are 72.15% which is above the Institution-set Standard of 70%. Retention rates are strong with a five-year average of nearly 87%. Enrollments have remained consistent over the last four years with an average of 14 per year having dropped from 18 in year 2011/12. The number of classes offered has varied since 2011/12 with 111 sections offered and 1950 students enrolled to 2015/16 with 125 sections offered and 1749 students enrolled. The SLO's for all classes have NOT been mapped to ISLO's, which serve as the program learning outcomes for the University and General Studies degrees.

The PRC recommends the following:

- 1) The ECE, EDUC and FSS (HUSV) faculty work with Counseling Department to review the current courses in the degree and consider adding course options in disciplines of Psychology, Sociology and Communication Studies (e.g. PSYC 41, SOC 30, and CMST 10)
- 2) The program faculty map the SLO's to the ISLO's (Some courses are mapped and some are not including but not limited to ECE 12,14-17, 20,22,24,26,27,3, 30,40, 50,51,52,6-8, EDTE 51,52,61,62,71,72,73)
- 3) Program faculty consider offering or deactivating any courses not offered in the past 5 years.
- 4) The program faculty review enrollment trends and work on increasing (where appropriate to curriculum, SLO's and so forth) the student enrollments per section.

Counselor response: 11.29.17 From Sue Loring: This degree is a great option for students, so I'm glad to see the recommendation is to continue without qualification. I'd like to point out that our current catalog indicates students must select classes from 2 areas, including FSS, and it identifies FSS 10,12, 16,18, 25, 26, 27, 46, and 60 as specific choices available. However, the department prefixes for those courses have changed. It would be nice to have the correct, updated prefixes listed. Students looking for FSS classes in MyShasta or the college catalog won't find any there.

2.12.18 From Carolyn Borg: Yes, as a counselor I find the General Studies – Human Development degree a good option for our extended ed students. We're unable to offer all of the ECE courses in Trinity, Weaverville, and Tehama. This permits students interested in education to complete a degree. (ECE 7 and 8 require a lab experience and ECE faculty don't support ITV for these classes.) It also becomes a good option for online students.

The FSS courses do need to be updated to: HUSV 10, 12, 16, 18, NUTR 25, NUTR 25H, NUTR 27, HUSV 46, 60. Also add HUSV 70 to the list, new to the HUSV discipline.
