


Bachelor's through Online and Local Degrees (BOLD) Information and Intake Form



BOLD Program Overview

The BOLD program is a Shasta College student support program for students who are pursuing a bachelor's degree completion program, through an online or local university. Students in Shasta College's Health Information Management Bachelor's degree program are also eligible to participate in BOLD.

BOLD Program Basics

- **Information: Identified university pathways in selected majors**

Shasta College has reviewed a number of universities and their programs, and we identified programs that will allow you to complete your bachelor's degree at an affordable cost without having to leave the northstate area. You are welcome to consider **ANY** university and/or major; you are not limited to our list.

- **Support: One-unit Shasta College Student Development (STU) classes**

Four one-unit Shasta College STU classes, taken concurrently with your bachelor's degree program, are what define the BOLD student support program. They are designed to help you adjust to your new university and develop your career pathway. The classes are:

- STU 40: Getting Connected to Your University
- STU 41: Career Focus
- STU 44: Career Worksite Readiness
- STU 45: Success in Graduate/Professional School

These classes will also allow you to connect with other local students (see BOLD Cohorts below) and access Shasta College campus resources: computer labs, the library, tutoring and learning centers, high speed internet, the health center, and more. Shasta College can continue to be your physical academic "home."

- **Connections: BOLD Cohorts**

Pursuing your educational goals can be lonely, especially if you are doing online studies. The STU classes will allow you to connect with other students who are completing their bachelor's degrees. This group will act as a support system for you as you work towards your goal. If Shasta College is your academic "home," then the BOLD Cohort is your academic "family."


To participate in BOLD

1. Review information from the first page of this packet and the BOLD website. If you have any questions about the program, contact the BOLD Office in room 784 on the main Shasta College campus in Redding (530-242-7676).
2. If you are interested in being part of the BOLD student support program (i.e., taking the STU classes at Shasta College concurrently with your university studies), please make sure that you are an active student in the Shasta College system and have submitted a FAFSA/CCPG (formerly BOG Fee Waiver) application for Shasta College.
 - a. If you were never a Shasta College student before, you must apply online to Shasta College at www.ShastaCollege.edu/NewStudents
 - i. The Shasta College BOLD Counselor will exempt you from other new student steps such as orientation and assessment.
 - b. Financial Aid:
 - i. The Shasta College Foundation is paying the unit fee and campus fee for the first 100 BOLD students for the Student Development classes. However, we are asking that students apply for the FAFSA/CCPG (formerly BOG Fee Waiver) application to see if they qualify for the CCPG (this helps preserve Shasta College Foundation funds for other efforts).
3. Meet with our BOLD Counselor to determine your transfer readiness for your intended bachelor's degree institution. Call 530-242-7676 to make an appointment with Rebecka Renfer.
 - a. If you have never attended Shasta College before, you must apply online to Shasta College before this appointment.
 - b. Rebecka may determine that you also need to speak with an advisor at your intended university to determine your preparedness for your specific major.
4. The earlier you turn in your BOLD Intake Form and Statement of Understanding (last 2 pages of this packet), the better we can help you prepare for your transfer.

Financial Aid

1. For Shasta College BOLD Student Development (STU) classes:
 - a. Submit the CA College Promise Grant (CCPG – formerly BOG Fee Waiver) application and a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the year you intend to start www.shastacollege.edu/FA (links to CCPG and FAFSA).
 - b. List Shasta College on your FAFSA.
2. For your university:
 - a. List your university on the FAFSA (in addition to Shasta College).
 - b. Follow up with your university's financial aid process on your university portal.
 - c. All financial aid for your university coursework will be handled by your university's financial aid office.
 - d. If you are confused about your university Financial Aid, you can ask for help from the BOLD Office. We can help you troubleshoot and guide you in how to approach your university's financial aid office.




My signature below indicates that I understand the following about the BOLD Program:

- Bachelor's degree institution:** With the exception of the Health Information Management Bachelor's degree offered by Shasta College, all Bachelor's degrees are offered by colleges or universities *other than Shasta College*. I will be a student at the university, and I have the option of also taking a one-unit BOLD STU class through Shasta College concurrently each term.
- University Transfer:** It is my responsibility to apply for admission to my university for transfer. The BOLD Office and the Transfer Center are available to help me with this process.
- Academic Counseling:** It is my responsibility to connect with the academic advisor in my major at my university to determine my readiness for transfer. If there is coursework I can complete at Shasta College prior to transferring, the Shasta College BOLD Counselor can help me create an educational plan for those courses.
- Financial Aid:**
 - Shasta College STU classes: The first 100 BOLD Students will have their Shasta College STU courses paid for by the Shasta College Foundation. To preserve Foundation fund, I will apply for the CCPG Fee Waiver at Shasta College (use the CCPG Fee Waiver application or the FAFSA*). The CCPG is only available at California Community Colleges.
 - University coursework:* I must apply for financial aid for my university studies by listing my university on my FAFSA* and following up with my university's financial aid office.
 - *Complete the CA Dream Application instead of the FAFSA if you are an AB540 student.
- BOLD is a voluntary program:** I can apply to a university and pursue my Bachelor's degree without enrolling in the BOLD Shasta College Student Development (STU) classes, but if I do not enroll in BOLD STU classes, I am not "*in the BOLD program.*" I must be actively enrolled in the specific BOLD STU classes to be "*in the BOLD program.*"
