Conditions of Probation

Conditions of Probation

- (1) A student on probation may enroll in no more than 13 units during the fall and spring semesters and no more than 6 units during the summer term.
- (2) A student who is placed on probation for the first time must meet with a counselor prior to any additional registration for classes. Within a designated timeframe the student must also complete a Student Success Plan by either (1) meeting with a counselor for a 30-minute appointment or (2) attending a Student Success Workshop. If the student does not complete the Student Success Plan within the specified timeframe, the student will be required to enroll in one of the student success classes in order to register for classes the following semester.
- (3) A student on academic probation whose probation continues the following semester **and** who receives less than a 2.0 g.p.a. during that semester must meet with a counselor prior to any additional registration for classes. Within a designated timeframe the student must also complete a Student Success Plan by meeting with a counselor for a 30-minute appointment. The student may be required to enroll in one of the student success classes or attend 9 hours of student success workshops before the end of the term.
- (4) A student on progress probation whose probation continues the following semester **and** who receives a grade of "W" "I" and/or "NC" in 50% or more of the units in which the student is enrolled that semester must meet with a counselor prior to any additional registration for classes. Within a designated timeframe the student must also complete a Student Success Plan by meeting with a counselor for a 30-minute appointment. The student may be required to enroll in one of the student success classes or attend 9 hours of student success workshops by the end of the term.
