Student Responsibility

Chaperone Responsibility

Tour chaperones are expected to assist the Shasta College tour guide. It is the chaperone's responsibility to ensure appropriate student behavior. These expectations ensure that you and your students have a rewarding and safe experience at Shasta College. Shasta College reserves the right to end the tour should individuals in the group not abide by the Standards of Conduct.

Notable Policies and Regulations

- No one is allowed to leave the group or tour site without the permission of a staff member or chaperone.
- Students and their parents may be held responsible for damages to college facilities, including but not limited to furniture, fixtures, classrooms, equipment, computers, etc..
- Hate speech will not be tolerated and will be immediately referred to chaperones and Shasta College staff.
- Alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, tobacco products, and cigarettes including electronic cigarettes are not
 permitted at any time. Any student found to be under the influence or in possession of these items will be referred
 to chaperones and Shasta College staff.
- Phones, photography, or other applications will not be used to harass or intimidate any individual (student, chaperone, tour guides, staff, instructors etc.).
