


Labeling Guidelines for:

# UNIVERSAL WASTE

**Universal Wastes (UW) are wastes regulated pursuant to Title 22 CCR or HSC. All Universal Waste must be marked or labeled.**

The labels to be used shall be standard for all UW and will reflect the following information:

- Name and Address.
- UW Type.
- Accumulation start date.
