Observatory

2000 HVAC

Increment 1 of the project is complete. Increment 2 has been approved and will go out to bid next week. That will be the south area of the 2000 building.

Keying Access

We are working with Allegion. There are 569 cores and not all the cores are the same.

AMAG

There is a chip shortage, and the card readers are back ordered. We are starting to prepare doors with the wiring. We are starting with the 100 building. We are getting the electrical runs started for the wiring.

1800 Boiler Replacement

The project is in progress. The new boiler is expected at the end of November. We had the old boiler demoed two months ago in preparation of the new boiler arriving. There is no heat in the building right now.

1100 Sidewalk Project

The project is complete. A new sidewalk was put in from the south end of the new CIS building to the north side of the 1100 towards 1400. New door thresholds need to be done and that will be done in house.

Discuss Measure H Bond Projects

2400-2500-2600 Buildings HVAC & Exterior Refresh

The roof is being resealed, new eaves and fencing around compound.

2000 Building (Student Center) HVAC Replacement

Increment 2 is going out to bid. This will be the south area of the 2000.

SC Main Campus Electrical Substations

The containment pads and fencing has been installed for A & C. Phase 2 of the project will be installing A & C and wiring for all substations. The original location of the substation behind the 2000 had to be moved due to the original location blocking deliveries for food services. Phase 3 will be E & F. They have not been released for production and it will be up to a year to build.

Furniture Surplus Activity

All the surplus items were placed in the library and a staff preview day was held Friday, October 21st. About 25% of the items were selected by staff and placed back on campus. There was a surplus sale for local public school's last weekend. Anything that they selected will be donated to them. There will be a surplus sale for the public

SC Community Leadership Center

The estimated completion date for floors 2-4 is December 2022 and floor 5 is March 2023. There will be a public park with pathways and a stage in the area south of HSUC which used to be the HSUC parking lot.

SC Main Campus Electrical Substations

A&C Replacement- Infrastructure portion of project complete. E&F Replacement- Direct purchase by district through Rexel USA (Platt Electric); submittals process near completion.

SC Main Campus Keying & Access Control

Phase III – Electronic access equipment (AMAG) purchase and installation by World Telecom continuing- backordered materials to arrive in mid-Fall; electrical runs commencing.

RPSTC Phase III

Out to bid- Bid opening on Tuesday, November 1st.

200 Building (Library) Renovation – STATE FUNDED

Request for Approval to Proceed to Bid being submitted today to the Chancellor's Office.

800 Building (Instructional Classrooms) Renovation – STATE FUNDED

Approval of Preliminary Plans by the California Public Works Board expected at their November meeting.

2000 Building HVAC Replacement Project – Increment 1

Increment 1 is complete; Increment 2 going out to bid November 1st.

100 Building Renovation- Student Services One-Stop Shop

Request for proposal document for architect solicitation in process.

SC Main Campus Fiber Project – Phases II and III

Next phase of project to commence with fiber run from 700 to the vault adjacent to the 1800 building, followed by fiber runs from the 1800 building to the 1900 and 5200 buildings.
