Helpful to share unofficial transcripts with counselors at time of ED planning appointment. Send official transcripts at end of school year.

North State Promise Priority Registration



After applying, receiving a Student Id # and Username, seniors need to complete only two matriculation steps by April 15th in order to qualify for North State Promise Priority Registration

- 1. Complete New Student Online Orientation**
- 2. Complete an Education Plan**

Incentive to complete steps:

- Wednesday, May 11th North State Promise Priority Registration
- Wednesday, May 25th Open Registration for all students

California College Promise Grant

In order to qualify for the California College Promise Grant (CCPG) the student will need to:

1. Apply to Shasta College

2. Apply for Student Aid

Complete Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or CA Dream Act application (CADAA) for applicable academic year 2022-2023

3. Student must be a California Resident

or have AB540 residency

4. Student must qualify based on financial need

Shasta College Promise 1st & 2nd Year Free

Those students who do not qualify for the California College Promise Grant, can still qualify for the Shasta College Promise Program. If a student completes the following by April 15th and meet the following criteria listed on the following page they can qualify for their 1st and 2nd year free which covers the \$46 /unit fees.

FREE tuition for FIRST-TIME, FULL TIME Students for your first 2 years! If you've attended a college other than Shasta or attended classes as a high school student—you're still considered a first-time student!



Shasta College Promise Program Application

Shasta College will not require seniors to complete the Shasta College Promise application if we have the student listed on the North State Promise/Shasta College Promise Tracking log. We normally add seniors to this log as they complete Education Plans.

In Shasta County we have been improving data sharing arrangements that can also aid in adding students to this log prior to them completing an education plan.

Also known as First Year Free & Second Year Free

For many students attending Shasta College this Fall their tuition will be free for their first two years as long as they are first-time, full-time students. A new program, called the Shasta College Promise Program, is providing students who previously may have avoided going to school due to financial considerations, another chance at obtaining a college education. The Shasta Promise program is funded by a mix of private and public funds.

How to Apply

First-time Shasta College students who are California residents need to complete the following steps:

1. Apply for Admission at Shasta College.
2. Submit the Free Application for Federal Financial Aid (FAFSA), or the California Dream Act Application, for the 2021-2022 year.
3. Complete a new student orientation and education plan.
4. Submit the completed **Shasta College Promise Program Application** (PDF) by emailing it to the following Student Success Facilitator:

Please allow 3-5 business days for processing.

In order to match the FAFSA with your student records, please verify that Shasta College has your accurate Social Security number on file and you have added Shasta College to your FAFSA.

If your social security number is not on file, please email the following three documents to admissions@shastacollege.edu:

1. A copy of your **social security card** (must be signed if 18+)
2. A copy of an **ID** (government issued or high school ID)
3. A completed **Change of Information/Major Form**

Shasta College Promise Program Criteria

Students must be a full-time student and **MAINTAIN 12 UNITS** from the **First Semester** to remain eligible.

If a student takes less than 12 units their first semester they would no longer be eligible for the program.

Students are considered first-time students after graduating from high school. Having taken dual enrollment or concurrent courses while still in high school does not impact being considered a first-time Shasta College student.

Spring 2022 graduates taking courses the summer of 2022 can do so and it will not impact them being a “first-time” student, yet the California College Promise Grant and Shasta College Promise Program won’t cover fees until Fall 2022. The exception could be if a student was to sign up to take 12 units during the summer, but this is not usually advisable due to the nature of the short-term more intensive coursework.
