BUT, KEEP READING WITH YOUR CHILD EACH DAY--AN IMPORTANT PART OF THEIR HEALTHY DEVELOPMENT!



Supporting children to grow and develop at their own healthy pace is truly a team effort. Our teachers and your family make up your child's early childhood educational team—with the shared goal to provide an optimal environment for learning and healthy development. Sometimes, even with an enriched, intentional learning environment, a child needs (or could benefit from) additional developmental support—usually from specialty services (e.g., speech, socialemotional/behavioral or other developmental support professionals). We depend on you, the parents/family, to complete the ASQ (Ages and Stages Questionnaire) assessment tool in order to provide information about your child's development. (Thank you for completing this through our new online method.) This enables our teachers to use the information while they complete their classroom developmental assessments (i.e., DRDP and Developmental Domains) during the semester/year. By working together, any areas needing extra support can be identified and addressed early on. The earlier the developmental need is supported, the more likely developmental growth success is realized for the child. Please speak with your child's teacher if you believe your child might need extra support. Speech and developmental assessments are available for children ages 3+ through our school district.
