SECTION 2 - Changes to the PRC Bylaws

- A. Amendments to the Bylaws:
 - Proposals to amend the Bylaws may be made by any member of the PRC.
 - 2. Proposals will appear on the PRC Agenda.
 - Changes shall pass with two-thirds approval of all voting members present.
 - If the motion to consider changes is passed, the proposed changes to the Bylaws will be effective immediately.
 - Suspension of a Bylaw: The PRC may suspend a Bylaw for the purpose of a single item in extraordinary circumstances with a two-thirds approval of all voting members present, regardless of quorum.
