

RABA Joint Task-force Resolution

Whereas, Under current financial constraints it has been deemed inappropriate by the State's FCMAT (Financial Crisis & Management Team) to spend approximately 25% of the yearly budget on less than 8% of the student population for a semester's worth of transportation;

Whereas, The general student population are paying an Events & Activities Fee to pay for the transportation of a minority of students, when they demand that the Senate provide events and activities as prescribed by the Senate Constitution; and

Whereas, The asked for price from RABA, per semester, is greater than our entire yearly income;

Resolve, That the Shasta College Student Senate shall not enter into an agreement with RABA to provide transportation services to students for the Fall 2011 semester;

Resolved, That the Shasta College Student Senate ask RABA to continue to acquire ridership data and submit it to the RABA Joint Task-force at the end of the Fall Semester;

Resolve, That the Shasta College Student Senate shall reopen negotiations with RABA to provide transportation services to students at such time in the future that it is feasible to do so; and

Resolved, That the Senate disburse funds reserved for the RABA negotiation into accounts that are deemed appropriate by the Ways & Means Standing Committee.
