The VSO representative can provide information, guidance, and assistance on a variety of topics, including:

- Comprehensive benefits counseling;
- Claims preparation and submission;
- Claims follow-up to ensure final decisions are fully and correctly adjudicated;
- Initiate and develop all appeals;
- Mental health resources;
- Vocational rehabilitation;
- CalVet Fee Waiver eligibility;
- Military records requests and networking and advocacy with federal, state local agencies.
