Student Code of Conduct/Rights & Responsibilities



The Code of Conduct establishes guidelines and clarifies expectations for all students using the VSSC. Each student is responsible for following the rules and regulations set forth in the VSSC in addition to the Shasta College Student Standards of Conduct as outlined in Shasta College Board Policy 5500.

As a patron, you have the right to the following:

1. Use the VSSC without undue disturbance.
2. Be free from fear of intimidation, physical and emotional harm.
3. Expect that any and all disagreements will be discussed in an atmosphere of openness and mutual respect.
4. Expect that others will respect your personal belongings and boundaries.
5. Use the VSSC in a clean, safe and healthy environment.

It is your responsibility to adhere to the following Code of Conduct:

1. The VSSC is a public facility and is intended for use by students who have served in the United States Armed Services. This center is a privilege.
2. All students must sign in with a valid student ID number and name.
3. Respect furnishings, equipment, fellow Veterans, staff and their personal boundaries.
4. Do not leave your belongings in the center and pick-up all trash.
5. Be mindful of your use of time on the computers and in lounge area.
6. Be respectful of Veterans' food in the fridge.
7. Do not use another person's items without their permission.
8. Keep noise to a reasonable level that is conducive to all guests.
9. Veteran Student Workers are required to enforce all Code of Conduct policies.
