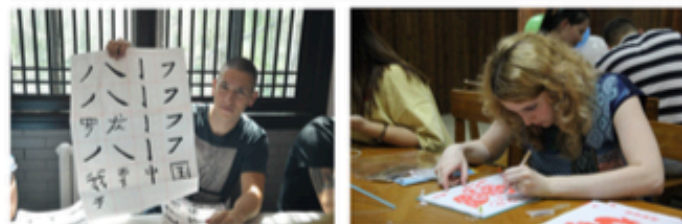
Students will study Chinese or business in the morning and participate in a combination of courses or activities in the afternoon. Besides, students have access to communicate with the local students to practice Chinese.
